As if to prove that Galicia really is different from the rest of Spain, the Rias Baixas had an earlier bud burst than the previous year, slightly lower temperatures and higher rainfall compared to a generally dry and warm year in the rest of the country. Nevertheless the quality suffered in no way with actually very similar quality between the two vintages.

harvest: 12th September to 9th October

wine-making: Destalking and pressing, followed by static decantation. Fermented at 16°C in stainless steel tanks over two weeks.

ageing: No oak ageing

blend: 100% Albariño

analysis: Alcohol: 12.40%
Acidity: 5.7 g/l
Volatile acidity: 0.2g/l
Residual sugars: 2.0g/l
pH: 3.35

date of bottling: Throughout the year, from en of January 2020 onwards.

total production: 10.000 bottles of 75 cl

tasting note: Bright and light golden in colour. Nose of medium intensity, with varietal aromas of apricot, pear and apples with a background of hay and fennel. The mouth is full and intense, with a greater weight and fullness than a typical albariño and a slightly lower acidity, making for a very friendly, easy-drinking but typical Albariño.
