type of wine: Organic dry white wine

vintage: 2019

After the large harvest of 2018, 2019 was generally a dry year and a somewhat smaller harvest than average. After a cool spring, a week in late June saw a surprising heatwave, but then summer settled down into a regular dry pattern with very little rainfall until the very end of the harvest, which was earlier than normal.

harvest: Third week of September.

wine-making: Destalking, gentle pneumatic press. Fermented at 16°C in stainless steel tanks, over 15 days.

vegan friendly: Yes

ageing: No oak ageing

blend: 50% Verdejo, 50% Airen

analysis: Alcohol: 12.17%  
Acidity: 5.73 g/l  
Residual sugars: 0.38 g/l  
pH: 3.29

date of bottling: Throughout the year, from March 2020 onwards.

total production: 33.000 bottles of 75 cl

tasting note: Aromas of tropical fruit such as pineapple and mango, overlaid with the subtle hints of fennel and cut grass. On the palate it is well-balanced, not over weighty, but refreshing and easy to drink.
